1. ABOUT THIS REPORT

This report seeks to track and illustrate the impact of Masingita Colliery's Social Development Programs through the implementation and guidance of The Xakwa Foundation team. This forms part of the Mine's commitment to annual impact assessment and transparent reporting to the Mine and all other Stakeholders. This report outlines short-term hunger alleviation progress and other social challenges that plague communities around the mine.

2. PROBLEM STATEMENT

As part of Masingita's social development programmes we aim to make a difference within the community of Delmas and surroundings farming communities. Through data collected by the Xakwa Foundation team, we were able to identify Siyonqoba School for the disabled who pleaded with us to assist with groceries, wheelchairs and day to day cleaning material. The school is home to 39 kids living with disabilities and they are in the care of volunteers and teachers at the school. When the request for assistance came we had to head the call. We intend on assisting this center at least 3 times a year.

Our reports cover the Mine's social responsibility progress, implementation, and level of commitment as contemplated in the mining charter. We report on SED and ESD projects for the mine on an ongoing basis through-out the mine's life span. As a responsible corporate citizen we advocate for impactful social, environmental and educational participation. **XAKWA FOUNDATION** creates positive social change through socio-economic empowerment of underprivileged communities around the mine's operational radius. The elderly, the disabled, school children from challenging backgrounds, orphans, registered NGO's and generally vulnerable members of society are our primary focus group and we are dedicated to assisting the mine in making a meaningful change, and strengthening relationships with its stakeholders.

This impact report documents Masingita Colliery's first SDP initiative since the opening of the mine. Through our business case studies we were in a position to formally introduce Masingita Mine project to the mayor, councillors, the department of Education, community leaders in Delams and local schools amongst other stakeholders from a Socio Economical point of view.

We were well received by the principal and founder who were very grateful for our contribution. The representative of the community Mr Yaya was very instrumental in communicating the cries of the school and alluded to how other mines and businesses do not commit to their promise of assistance.

In attendance at the Grocery drive was the CLO, the Xakwa Foundation Team, The Councillor who was attended on behalf of the mayor's office.

CHALLENGES AND FINANCIAL SHORTFALL

The budget for this initiative was conservative however we managed to make the best of it. A bakkie was hired for the team, Groceries were procured from the local Pic'N Pay and transported to the school. The school is in need of more assistance in the general maintenance of the facility.
